


# 2022 FLY UP TO 5K

**Family/Group Reunion Area:** Near the corner of Elm and Mehring Way, parents and group leaders will have access to Smale Park where the Family Fun Festival will be held on Saturday. The Reunion Area will be located inside the park near the Finish Line exit. The participants will exit the secured Finish Line near this area. Please instruct your family/group to meet in the reunion area marked with "Reunion" signage underneath the fruit.

**Where do we go for the 5K start?**

The race will start at 9:00am on Mehring Way between Elm Street and Central Avenue. Each group has been given a group sign to hold before and after the event to help identify themselves among the crowd and to help reunite group participants. Many group leaders select a meeting place to gather and then go to their corral. We recommend the plaza level of Paul Brown stadium off of Elm Street near the packet pick up tents on the East side of the Stadium. Each participant is assigned a corral based on their expected finish time.

**What is a corral and how will the 5K Start Line work?**

The Flying Pig 5K has nearly 5,000 participants. A portion of these participants will be completing the event as part of the Fly Up to 5K youth program. With a goal to improve the race day experience for all participants, the Flying Pig has instituted corrals or "Pig Pens" for the 5K. Corral assignments are based on expected finish time and will be included on your bib. Please allow extra time to find and position your group in their correct Pig Pen. Late arriving participants will not be guaranteed placement in their correct Pig Pen. If you need to change your assigned corral, please visit the Corral Assignment booth at the expo or the registration/packet pick up tent on site before the race on Saturday. Please note that you are allowed to move back a corral, but you're not permitted to move up a corral at the Start.

**Can a parent run/walk with their child?**

In order to ensure the utmost safety and security for all participants, spectators, staff, volunteers and officials, we ask that all people on any Flying Pig Marathon race course be an officially registered participant, or an official volunteer. If your child is not part of an organized group with chaperones, you can register as a participant and stay with them on the course or have a clear plan for meeting after the finish. Adults can register online through April 27th, or at the expo on April 29th, pending the event is not sold out. **Be sure to fill out race day contact information on the back of each child's race bib.**

**How do we see the children finish and where do they exit?**

The Finish Line needs to be a safe and secure place. Unfortunately, we cannot allow spectators access inside the finish area. Once participants cross the Finish "Swine", they will be directed to chutes that will keep them moving toward their medals, and recovery snacks. They will exit into Smale Park and the Group/Family Reunion Area marked with signs. It is a good idea for you to show this area to your child before the race. The Start and Finish Line are close together this year. Parents can easily maneuver from the Start Line to the Finish Line to watch their child start/finish.

**What do I do with my Hog Log?**

Your Hog Log is your own personal record of your training and commitment to making healthy choices. We love getting them back so we can brag about the healthy habits of our participants. You're welcome to keep it or download another one and keep on logging those miles.
